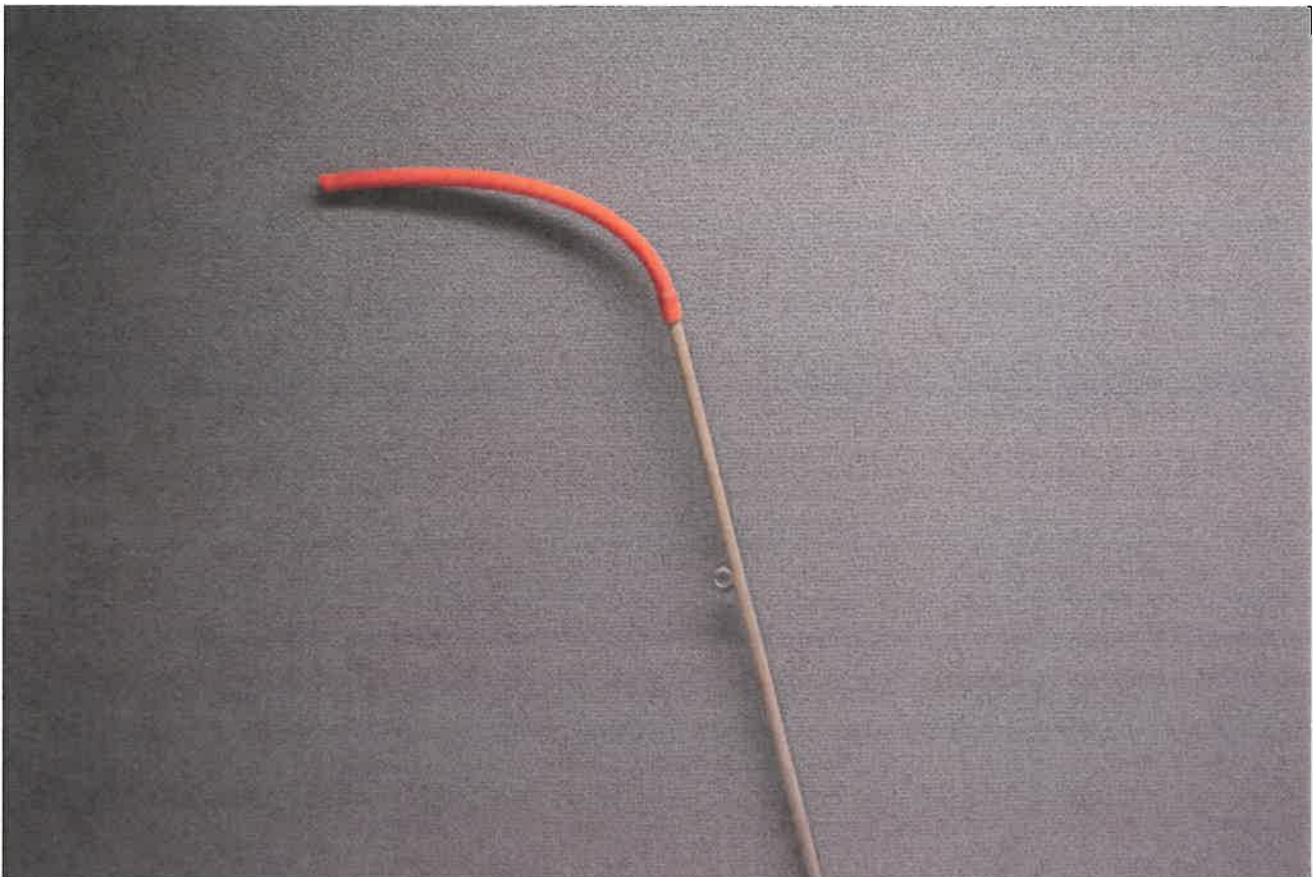


# D.I.Y. Cat and Dog Toy Manual

## Cat Wands

### Supplies:

- Scissors
- Rubber tubing (You can order the rubber tubing from <http://www.neckz.com/>)
- ARF's animal care order packages of 60 tubes, which they cut in half)
- 12inch long  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch wooden dowels (You can buy long dowels at most hardware stores, and cut them into 12 inch sections. Or, buy pre-cut dowels at a craft store <http://www.michaels.com/creatology-wood-dowels-0.25in/10031021.html>)



### Instructions:

Step 1: Slide rubber tube onto 12 inch dowel

Step 2: That's it - All done!

# Braided Dog Tug Toy

Supplies: Fabric, fabric scissors



## Instructions:

Step 1: Cut fabric into three strips that are approximately 2 feet in length and 4 inches wide.

Step 2: Tie the strips together at the top into a firm knot.

Step 3: Braid the strips into a tight braid.

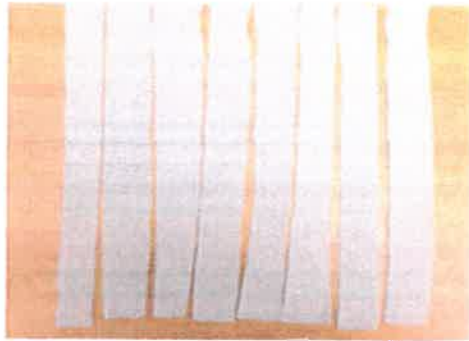
Step 4: Tie the bottom of the braid into a firm knot.

# Cat Toy Pom Pom Balls

**Supplies:** Fabric, Fabric Scissors

## **Instructions:**

Step 1: Cut approximately 20 strips of fabric, approximately 6 inches in length



Step 2: Make a stack of at least 20 strips and tie them together in the center with another fabric strip.



Step 3: Fluff!



# No Sew Fleece Blankets

Supplies: Fleece fabric, fabric scissors



## Instructions:

Step 1: Select the fabric - Choose a print and a contrasting or matching solid. You will need a solid and a print that are the same size.

Step 2: Line up the two fabric pieces right sides OUT.

Step 3: Trim the two pieces so that they are the same size.

Step 4: Cut out the corners - Cut a small square from each of the four corners.

Step 5: Cut fringe on all four sides of the blanket. Cut through both layers of fabric at the same time. Fringe pieces should be a little wider than the width of your finger. Cut in from the edge.

Step 6: Begin tying knots. Leave your blanket laying flat on the surface, with all fringes lined up. Tie a knot like you would make with a shoe lace.

Step 7: Continue around the blanket. Tie all the fringes together on all four sides of the blanket. All the knots should be snug up to the blanket, but not too tight. The finished blanket should lay flat.
